**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**  
**NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT TWO-FAILED BIDDINGS**

The Department of Agriculture, Regional Field Office No. 12, Koronadal City through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invites prospective and interested bidders for the following projects, to wit:

**1. Upgrading of Tire Path FMR in Datu Ladayon, Arakan, North Cotabato**

Project Duration : 110 calendar days  
Location : Datu Ladayon, Arakan, North Cotabato

The bidding will be conducted through open competitive procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184, otherwise known as the "Philippine Government Procurement Act".

Interested bidders may obtain further information from the Department of Agriculture, Regional Field Office No. 12 BAC Secretariat from 8:00AM to 5:00PM during working days.

**Opening of Bids** shall be on **September 10, 2015 at 09:00AM** in the **DA-RFO 12 Conference Room, Zulueta Street, Koronadal City.**

**Sealed Bids** must be delivered/submitted to the DA-RFO 12 BAC Secretariat Office **on or before 09:00AM of September 10, 2015;**

**Bids** shall be accompanied by a bid security either of the following schedule:

- 1. Cash or Cashier's/Manager's check issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank**  
- 2% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)
- 2. Bank Guarantee**  
- 2% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC)
- 3. Surety Bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security**  
- 5% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC); or
- 4. Bid Securing Declaration (duly notarized).**

**LATE BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

The Department of Agriculture, Regional Office No. 12, Koronadal City reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to waive any minor defects, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder/s and to accept bid as may be considered most advantageous to the government.
