Issued at 11:00AM, 19 April 2021

TYPHOON "BISING" MAINTAINS ITS STRENGTH AS IT SLOWLY MOVES NORTH-NORTHWESTWARD

On the forecast track, TY "BISING" will move generally northward or north northwestward until Wednesday (21 April) evening or Thursday (22 April) morning. Afterwards, the typhoon will move generally northeastward or east northeastward away from the landmass of Luzon. It is forecasted to gradually weaken from its current intensity throughout the remainder of the forecast period.

Today, moderate to heavy with at times intense rains will be experienced over Bicol Region, Northern Samar, Samar, Eastern Samar, Biliran and the northern portion of Leyte. Tomorrow (20 April), moderate to heavy rains will be experienced over Bicol Region and Northern Samar, while light to moderate with at times heavy rains may prevail over the northern portion of Aurora and the eastern portions of mainland Cagayan and Isabela.

The following activities are being done by the RFOs that will be affected by the tropical cyclone:

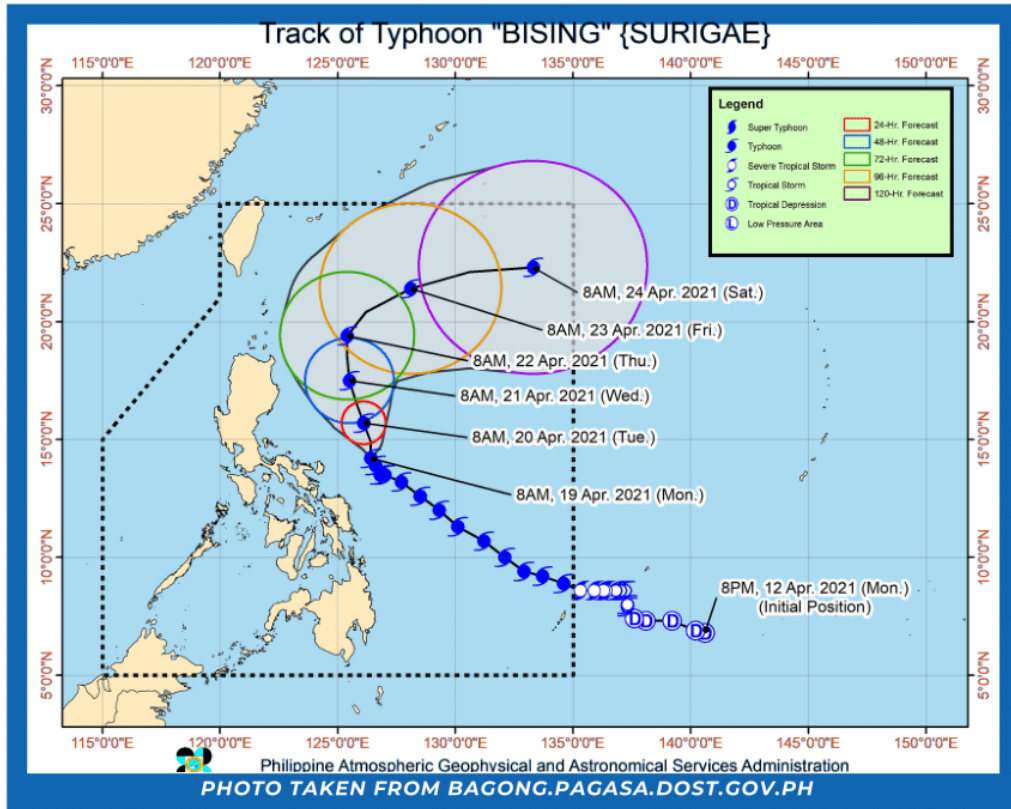
1. Activation of DA Regional DRRM Operation Centers;
2. Close monitoring of weather updates;
3. Issuance of advisories to provinces thru the Agricultural Program Coordinating Offices (APCOs);
4. Close coordination with the Local Government Units counterparts, and other Regional DRRM-related offices in monitoring of the typhoon;
5. Monitoring of actual field situation for possible damage that may be incurred in crops and livestock;
6. Prepositioning of seeds of rice, corn and vegetables; drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry.

AT 10:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE EYE OF TYPHOON "BISING" WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **235 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF VIRAC, CATANDUANES OR 360 KM EAST OF DAET, CAMARINES NORTE** (14.3 °N, 126.3 °E). IT IS MOVING **NORTH NORTHWESTWARD SLOWLY** WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **195 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **240 KM/H**.

REGION	WEATHER
II	Mostly cloudy skies with light winds in the region, except in Cagayan Province with scattered rainshowers
III	Fair weather is being observed in the region, even in Aurora province
IV-A	Cloudy skies in the region, except in Rizal and Laguna with sunny skies
V	Generally experiencing moderate to strong winds with heavy rains
VIII	Moderate to heavy rainshowers with moderate to strong winds in Samar Island; occasional light to moderate rain with light to strong winds in Leyte, Southern Leyte and Biliran
XIII	Cloudy skies with scattered light rainshowers and light to moderate winds prevail in the region
