



Issued at 4PM, 12 April 2022

### "AGATON" IS NOW MOVING OVER LLORENTE, EASTERN SAMAR

The center of Tropical Depression "AGATON" was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of Llorente, Eastern Samar moving Eastward slowly. It has maximum sustained winds of 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 75 km/h.

On the forecast track, "AGATON" will continue moving slowly eastward within the next 6 to 12 hours before turning more east southeastward towards the Philippine Sea beginning tonight or tomorrow morning (Apr 13).

"AGATON" is forecast to deteriorate into a remnant low within the next 24 hours that will continue tracking generally eastward over the Philippine Sea as it becomes assimilated within the circulation of Typhoon "BASYANG".

Meanwhile, "BASYANG" has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility at 10:00 AM today, yet it is unlikely to directly affect the weather condition in the country.

### DAMAGE AND LOSSES

Damage and losses have been reported in Eastern Visayas, and Caraga amounting to P270.3 million (M) affecting 2,199 farmers, with volume of production loss at 16,866 metric tons (MT) and 3,168 hectares of agricultural areas.

Affected commodities include rice, corn, high value crops, and livestock. These values are subject to validation. Additional damage and losses are expected in areas affected by "AGATON".

### AVAILABLE INTERVENTIONS

The following assistance will be provided to the affected farmers and fishers:

1. Rice, corn and assorted vegetable seeds;
2. Drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry
3. Survival and Recovery (SURE) Program of Agricultural Credit Policy Council (ACPC);
4. Available funds from Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC) to indemnify affected farmers; and
5. Quick Response Fund (QRF) for the rehabilitation of affected areas.
