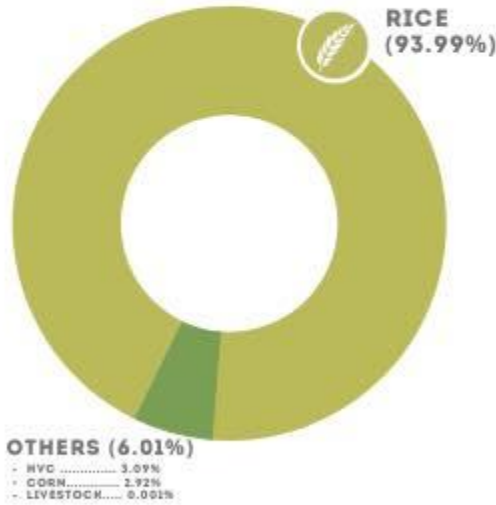

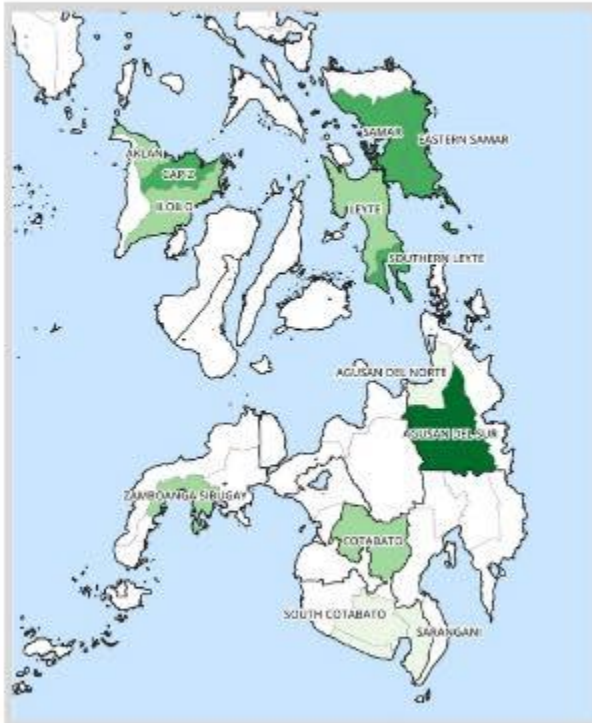

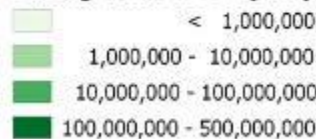

INTERVENTIONS

The following assistance will be provided to the affected farmers and fishers:

Rice, corn and assorted vegetable seeds from affected regions;

Drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry

Survival and Recovery (SURE) Program of Agricultural Credit Policy Council (ACPC)

Available funds from Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC) to indemnify affected farmers

Quick Response Fund (QRF) for the rehabilitation of affected areas;

DAMAGE AND LOSSES

Damage and losses have been reported in Western Visayas, Eastern Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Soccsksargen and Caraga amounting to P639.7 million (M) affecting 10,453 farmers, with volume of production loss at 36,846 metric tons (MT) and 16,251 hectares of agricultural areas.

Affected commodities include rice, corn, high value crops, and livestock. These values are subject to validation.

Additional damage and losses are expected in areas affected by "AGATON".

ACTIONS TAKEN

The Department of Agriculture (DA), through its Regional Field Offices (RFOs), is conducting assessment of damage and losses brought by TD "AGATON" in the agri-fisheries sector.

The DA continuously coordinates with concerned NGAs, LGUs and other DRRM-related offices for the impact of "AGATON", as well as available resources for interventions and assistance.

AVAILABLE INTERVENTIONS

The following assistance will be provided to the affected farmers and fishers:

1. Rice, corn and assorted vegetable seeds;
2. Drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry;
3. Survival and Recovery (SURE) Program of Agricultural Credit Policy Council (ACPC);
4. Available funds from Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC) to indemnify affected farmers; and
5. Quick Response Fund (QRF) for the rehabilitation of affected areas.
