PRESENT WEATHER :

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM "DANTE" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 650 KM EAST OF DAVAO CITY (7.6°N, 131.7°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL :

LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS AND THUNDERSTORMS

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED :

- **SOUTH COTABATO** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY SIQUIL, MAKAR AND BANGA.
- **NORTH COTABATO** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY LIBUNGAN, MALASILA, TOLIMAN-DUNAKLING, MARIDAGAO, KABACAN, MULETA, ARAKAN, KULAMAN, UPPER MLANG AND PULANGI.
- **SULTAN KUDARAT** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY TIAN AND KRAAN.
- **SARANGANI** - RIVERS AND ITS TRIBUTARIES PARTICULARLY KALAONG, BUAYAN-MALUNGON, LUN PADIDO, LUN MASLA AND GLAN.

PEOPLE LIVING NEAR THE MOUNTAINS SLOPES AND IN THE LOW LYING AREAS OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED RIVER SYSTEMS AND THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS CONCERNED ARE **STILL ADVISED TO TAKE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES.**
