Issued at 2:00PM, 31 May 2021

TROPICAL STORM "DANTE" SLIGHTLY INTENSIFIES WHILE MOVING NORTHWESTWARD OVER THE PHILIPPINE SEA.

The center of TS "DANTE" was located 515 km East Northeast of Davao City or 445 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur moving Northwestward at 20 km/h.

Based on available data, "DANTE" is forecasted to further intensify and may reach Severe Tropical Storm Category. Its outer rainbands will bring light to moderate with at times heavy rain over Caraga and Davao Region, SOCCSKSARGEN, Bukidnon, and Misamis Oriental.

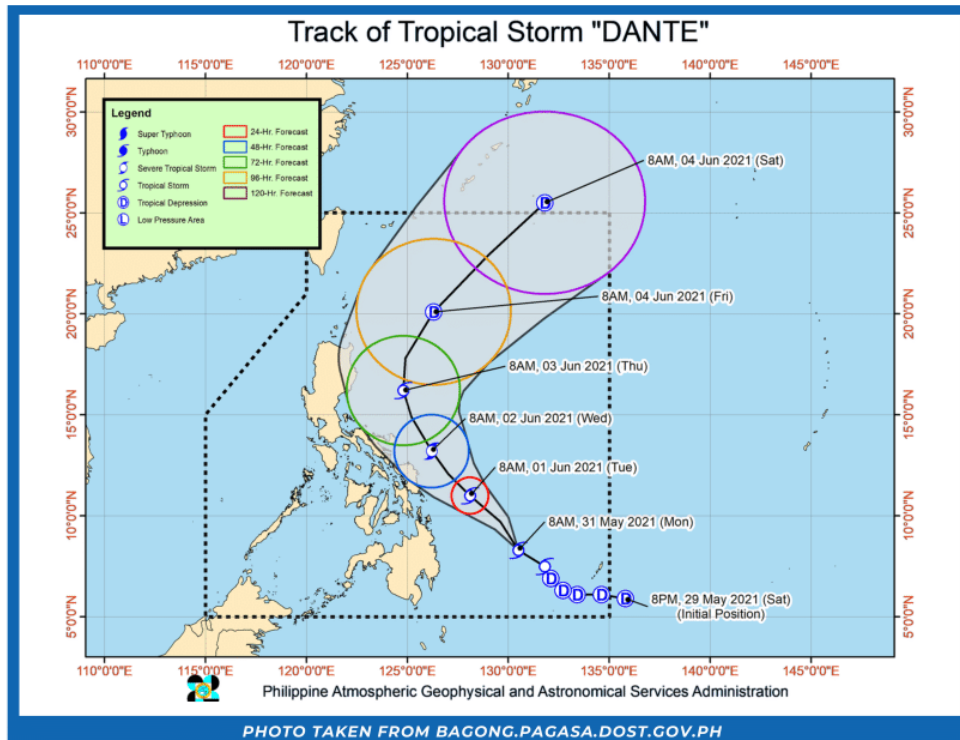
The following activities are being done by the RFOs that will be affected by the tropical cyclone:

1. Activation of DA Regional DRRM Operation Centers;
2. Issuance of advisories to provinces thru the Agricultural Program Coordinating Offices (APCOs);
3. Close coordination with the Local Government Units counterparts, and other Regional DRRM-related offices in monitoring of the tropical storm;
4. Monitoring of actual field situation for possible damage that may be incurred in crops, livestock and fisheries;
5. Prepositioning of seeds of rice and corn; drugs and biologics for livestock and poultry.

Bulletin No. 1 on Tropical Storm "DANTE" SITUATIONER REPORT



AT 10:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TS "DANTE" WAS ESTIMATED AT 515 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF DAVAO CITY OR 445 KM EAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (8.3°N, 130.4°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 75 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 90 KM/H. ON THE FORECAST TRACK, "DANTE" WILL REMAIN OVER THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA, YET IT MAY GRADUALLY INTENSIFY INTO A SEVERE TROPICAL STORM.
