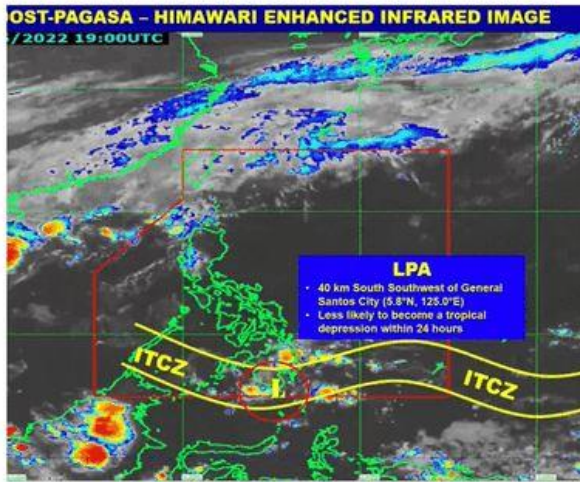

Caraga, Davao Region, and SOCCSKSARGEN	ITCZ / LPA	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
