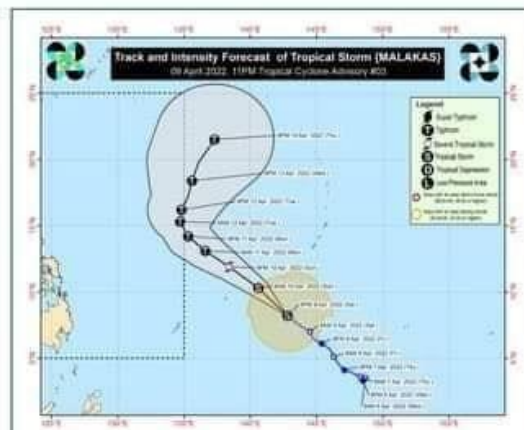




**PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS**



- **TS "AGATON"**
  - 📍 over the coastal waters of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.1°N, 125.9°E)
  - 🌀 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h
  - 🏠 West northwestward at 10km/h
- **Low Pressure Area**
  - 📍 415 km West Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.2°N, 115.3°E)



- **TS "MALAKAS" (OUTSIDE PAR)**
  - 📍 1,965 km East of Mindanao (7.1°N, 144.1°E)
  - 🌀 75 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 90 km/h
  - 🏠 Northwestward at 20 km/h
  - ⚠️ May enter PAR on Monday or Tuesday

Tropical Storm "AGATON" was estimated based on all available data at over the coastal waters of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (11.0°N, 126.2°E). It is moving West Northwest at 10 km/h.

A Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 415 km West Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (8.2°N, 115.3°E).

Tropical Storm "MALAKAS" outside PAR 1,790 km east of Mindanao (9.4°N, 141.8°E). It is moving Northwestward at 25 kph and is expected to enter PAR on Monday or Tuesday.
