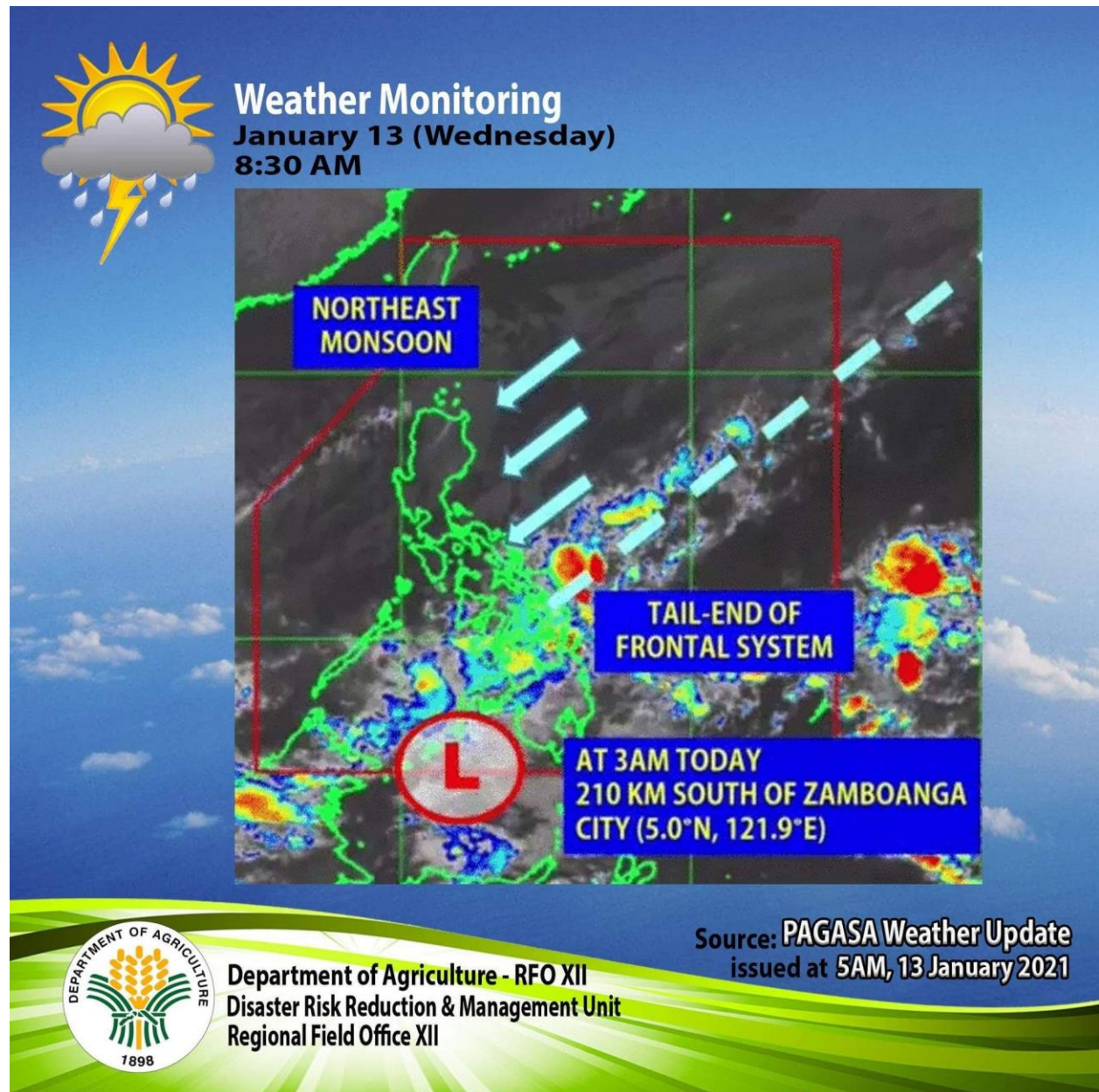


[#WeatherUpdate](#) | PAGASA Weather Forecast for 13 January 2021 (Wednesday, AM Forecast)
