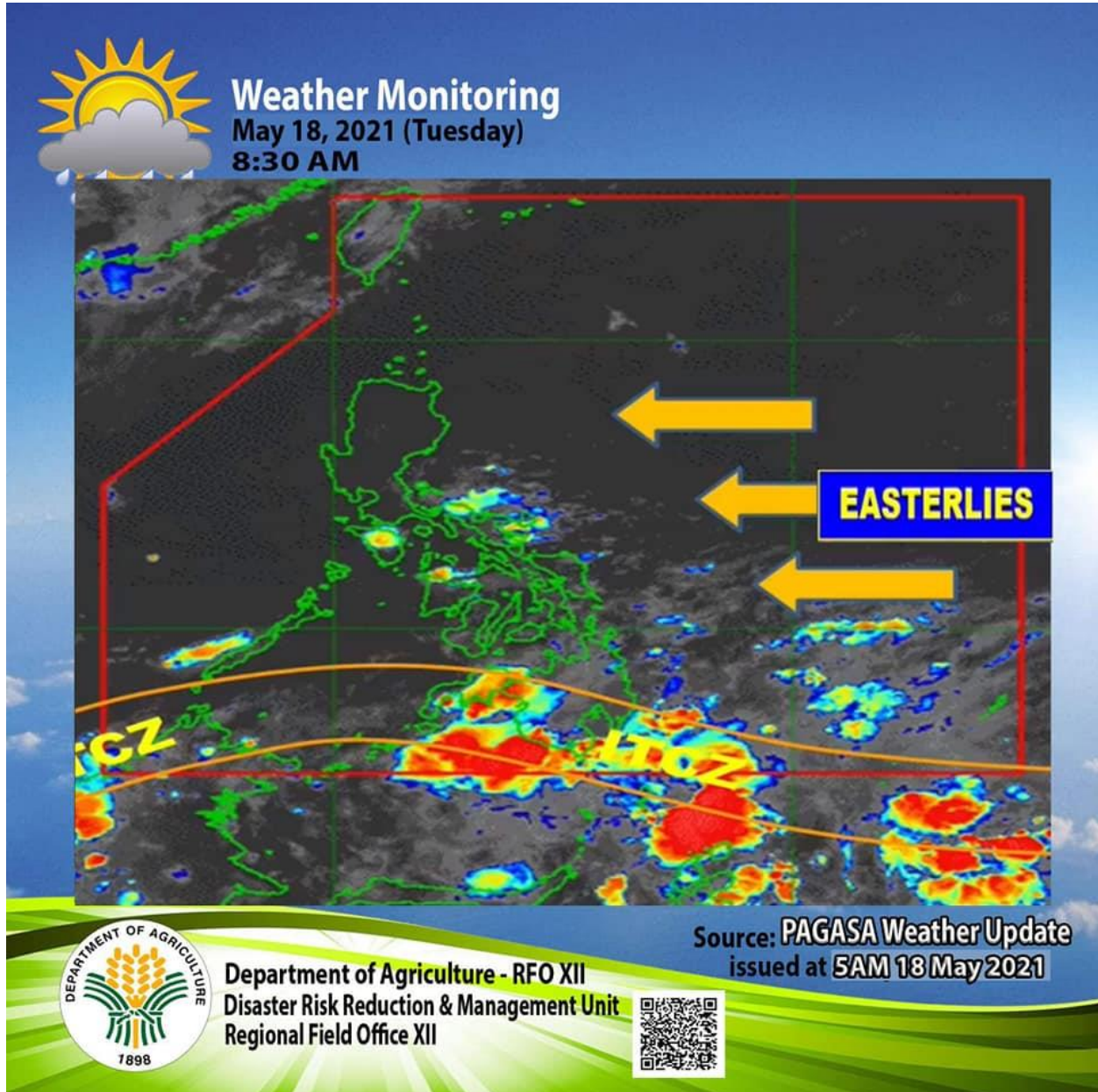


PAGASA Weather Forecast for 26 May 2021 (Wednesday, AM Forecast)

A Low Pressure Area was estimated at 825 km East of Mindanao. It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao. The LPA has a low chance of developing to a tropical cyclone and is forecast to dissipate within 24 hours. Easterlies affecting the rest of the country.
