● Tropical Depression "Caloy"

- 📍 565 km West of Central Luzon (15.4°N, 114.7°E)
- 🌀 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h
- 👉 West Southwest at 40 km/h

● Low Pressure Area

- 📍 1,020 km East of Northern Luzon (17.2°N, 131.3°E)
- May develop into a Tropical Depression within the next 48 hours

● Southwest Monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.

Active Tropical Cyclone (formerly TD "Caloy") outside PAR is located at 565 km west of Central Luzon (15.4°N, 114.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h. It is moving West Southwest at 40 km/h.

We are also currently monitoring a Low Pressure Area (LPA) that was estimated based on all available data at 1,020 km East of Northern Luzon (17.2°N, 131.3°E).

Southwest Monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.

Possible flash floods or landslides due to scattered to widespread moderate to at times heavy rains or severe thunderstorms.
