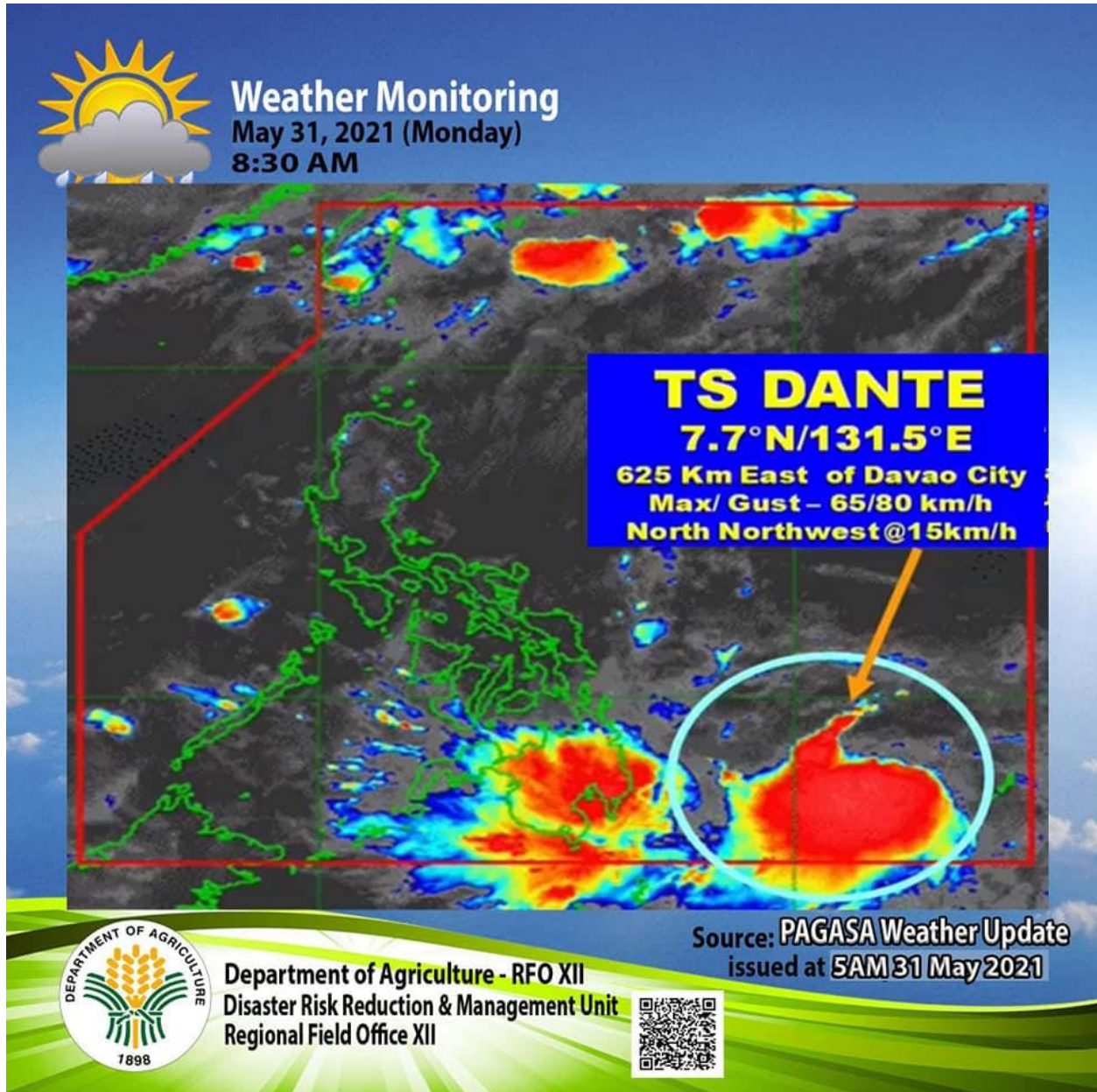


PAGASA Weather Forecast for 31 May 2021
(Monday, AM Forecast)

“DANTE” INTENSIFIES INTO A TROPICAL STORM

TS “DANTE” will likely remain over the Philippine Sea throughout the forecast period and is forecast to gradually intensify in the next two days before weakening throughout the remainder of the forecast period.

It will bring cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorm over Mindanao, Central and Eastern Visayas; and partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers over Metro Manila and the rest of the country.
