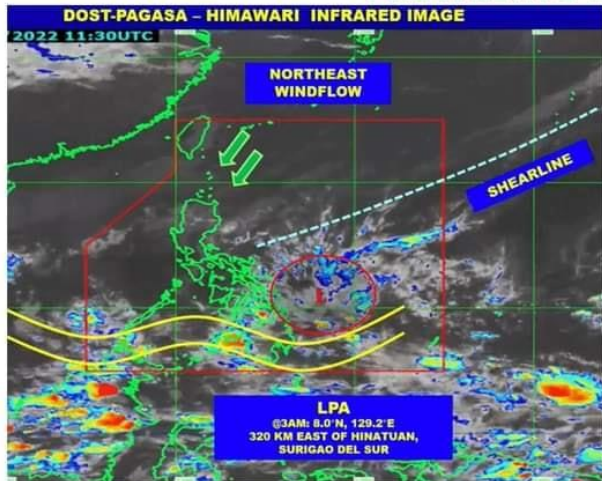




## PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS

- **Low Pressure Area (LPA)**
  - 📍 320 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.0°N, 129.2°E).
- It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao
- Shear Line affecting Southern Luzon.

## FORECAST WEATHER CONDITIONS

Region/Province	Weather System	Effects
Metro Manila, Cagayan Valley, Aurora, Bulacan and CALABARAZON	Northeasterly Surface Windflow	Cloudy skies with rains
Bicol Region	Shear Line	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Visayas and Mindanao	ITCZ / LPA	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
The rest of Luzon	Northeasterly Surface Windflow	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains
