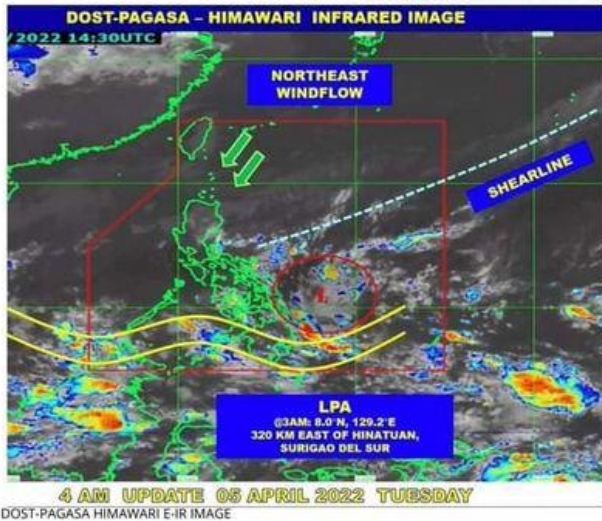




PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS



- **Low Pressure Area (LPA)**
 - 📍 15 km Northeast of Davao City or in the vicinity of Laak, Davao de Oro (7.5°N, 125.9°E)
- **Possible flash floods or landslides during moderate to at times heavy rains**

Palawan and Mindanao	Low PResure Area (LPA)	Cloudy skies with scattered to widespread rainshowers and thunderstorms
Visayas	Low PResure Area (LPA)	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon and Quezon	Northeasterly Windflow	Cloudy skies with rains
Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon	Northeasterly Surface Windflow	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains
