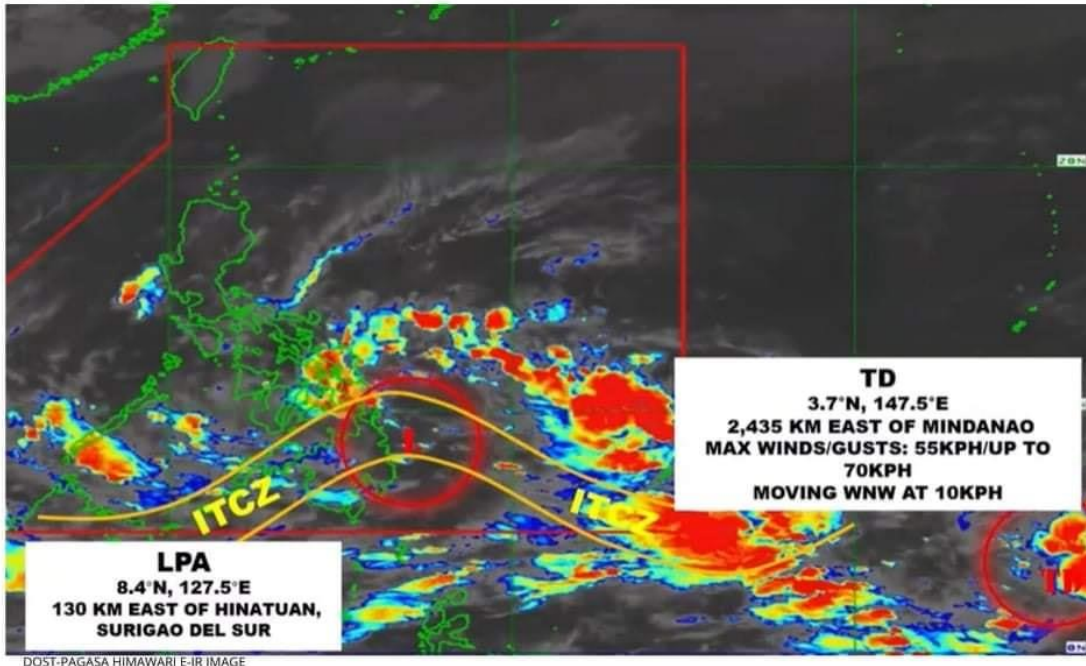




PREVAILING WEATHER SYSTEMS



● Low Pressure Area (LPA)

- 📍 130 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.4°N, 127.5°E)
- ⚠️ Low chance of developing into a Tropical Cyclone

● Tropical Depression **OUTSIDE PAR**

- 📍 2,435 km East of Mindanao (3.7°N, 147.5°E)
- 🌀 55 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h
- 👉 West Northwestward at 10 km/h
- ⚠️ May enter PAR on Monday

● Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao.

FORECAST WEATHER CONDITIONS

Region/Province	Weather System	Effects
Visayas, Mindanao, MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, and Quezon	LPA / ITCZ	Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms
Cagayan Valley, Apayao, Kalinga, Ifugao, Mountain Province, and Aurora	Northeasterly Surface Windflow	Cloudy skies with rains
Ilocos Region, Abra, and Benguet	Northeasterly Surface Windflow	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains
Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon	Localized Thunderstorms	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms

PAGASA Weather Forecast for 7 April 2022 (Thursday, AM Forecast)

At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 130 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.4°N, 127.5°E). It is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao. We are also monitoring a tropical cyclone outside PAR (2,435 km east of Mindanao). It is moving West Northwestward at 10 kph and is expected to enter PAR on Monday.

Possible flash floods or landslides during moderate to at times heavy rains or severe thunderstorms.

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
