# 2013 Agri Pinoy Corn Program Highlights of Accomplishments

Soccsksargen Region was among the top 10 corn producers in the country where we ranked **number 2** all throughout the Philippines with a production of 1,291,343 metric tons posting a contribution of 18 percent to national corn production performance.

The region had posted an increase of 7% compared in Crop Year 2012 of 1,201,331 metric tons production.

Increase in production was attributed to production support services with 1.0 ton increment, PHF development 0.5 tons and extension support services 0.5 tons having a total increment of 2.0 tons.

#### A. PRODUCTION SUPPORT SERVICES

**1.** Support to open-pollinated variety (OPV) white corn seeds production and cassava seed pieces propagation.

The Agri-Pinoy Corn Program planted **11 hectares of OPV white corn seeds** and **20 hectares cassava seed pieces** in DA 12's research outreach stations for the purpose of massive reproduction to be used for distribution during extreme climate conditions.

Under the Rehabilitation Assistance Program, the region was able to distribute **1,700 bags of OPV white corn seeds** and **351 bags of hybrid corn seeds** with a total of 2,051 bags to calamity-affected provinces in Region 12

## 2. Organic-Based Agriculture

The program continually supported the conduct of soil mapping and sampling program. There were at least 602 soil samples analyzed and 2,408 soil tests conducted with 300 farmer-beneficiaries.

# 3. Biological Control Program

Trichogramma production was undertaken at the Regional Crop Protection Center (RCPC) in Barangay Lagao, General Santos City and in Barrio II, Tacurong City with a total of 1,973,000 tricho cards and distributed to 29, 210 farmer-beneficiaries. Total area covered wa about 35,487 hectares.

# 4. Pilot Farm Mechanization and Tractor Pool Program.

As part of the government's effort to mechanize farming in our region, the program distributed twelve (12) Heavy Duty 90 HP farm tractors to the following recipients:

### A. MARKETING DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

To improve market development services, nine (9) matching market linkages were undertaken and 48 corn marketing and price information networks were completed to provide timely price and market information.

## **B. EXTENSION SUPPORT, EDUCATION AND TRAINING SERVICES**

Extension Support, Education and Training Services posted a 100 percent accomplishment. Corn specialist training, technology demonstrations, farmers' field school (FFS), entrepreneurial courses (Corn Husk Handicraft Training), post-harvest technology promotion, Bantay Peste Brigade training, other trainings and technical briefings, Cassava trainings and support to FFS and Integrated Pest Management were among those lined-up activities.

A total of 11,590 information, education, and campaign (IEC) materials were distributed as part of our advocacy strategies. The program also provided incentives to Two Hundred Eighty (280) agricultural extension workers (AEWs) as part of local government's extension linkages.

Research and development services has a 100 percent accomplishment based on the trial conducted and evaluated during the agency in-house research review conducted by external evaluators from the Bureau of Agricultural Research and the University of Southern Mindanao.

#### D. REGULATORY SUPPORT SERVICES

We were not able to cope with the target due to the transfer of laboratory facilities and equipments to the Regional Crop Protection Center in Tacurong, Sultan Kudarat having only a 79 % physical accomplishment.

#### E. POLICY FORMULATION AND ADVOCACY SERVICES

The APP Corn Program has a physical accomplishment of 100 percent in the conduct of our services for the SOCCSKSARGEN region having 4 provinces and 5 chartered cities on policy and advocacy campaign through conduct of complementation forum, Ulat sa Bayan, Congresses and dialogues to all corn farmers and stakeholders.
